

## **BOSCH LAUNCHES SYSTEM FOR SEAMLESS MANAGEMENT OF DIGITAL VIDEO, AUDIO AND DATA OVER IP**

*Fairport, N.Y.* – Bosch Security Systems, Inc., a full-line manufacturer of high-quality security solutions, today announced the Bosch Video Management System (VMS), which allows security personnel to integrate CCTV products into a complete video surveillance solution that is easy to operate and manage. Designed to fit video installations both large and small, VMS is suitable for a wide range of applications, including government locations, banks, airports, railways and university campuses.

VMS offers an intuitive user interface to help security operators work more efficiently and respond faster to critical events. The sophisticated event and alarm management and advanced video content analysis capabilities ensure that security concerns are recognized quickly. Each alarm is displayed in a video row along with five image panes showing live or playback video, related documents or site maps to pinpoint the source of the alarm and make camera selection easier.

All live and archived video data can be viewed at numerous workstations simultaneously, regardless of the operators' locations. Along with system-wide event and alarm management, system monitoring, configuration and user management capabilities span every site in an installation – from multiple buildings to multiple continents.

The Configuration Client eases installation and logs all changes made each time a new configuration is activated. System administrators can view changes made to the configuration along with the date and time of the changes and the person who made them.

VMS supports industry-standard servers, storage units and workstations, enabling IT personnel to leverage their existing investments. With LDAP support, VMS can be integrated with user management systems, such as Microsoft Active Directory, allowing the system to instantly recognize and give the appropriate permissions to new personnel once they are added to the master user database and assigned a group. Access to specific cameras, priority for pan-tilt-zoom control and rights for exporting video can be set for each user group. With Dual Authorization on Login, special privileges, such as the ability to review scenes in restricted areas or burn video to DVD, can be granted when a specified user logs in with the operator.

VMS supports Bosch's complete line of IP video products, including single and multi-channel MPEG-4 encoders, decoders, IP cameras and DiBos DVRs, as well as the Bosch IntuiKey CCTV keyboard. VMS can also be combined with Bosch's Building Integration System (BIS). With this integration, VMS will show live video from specific cameras in the event of an alarm triggered by BIS, start and stop recording of specified cameras or find video associated with a BIS alarm.
